Membership Agreement

Welcome to the Asheville Wedding Collective! We are a group of wedding and event vendors who value local, green, and budget-friendly weddings, events, and gifts. We strive to promote a culture of caring and sustainability through working together to brainstorm, plan, and accomplish our visions and that of our clients.

The Collective will provide:

- A listing on our website in all categories that your business falls under
- Bi-Monthly meetings open to all members of The Collective where you will have your voice heard in how The Collective should work and play together
- The Rehearsal - a yearly faux wedding where The Collective can showcase its varied talents
- Built-in networking
 - ◆ Meet a wide range of vendors that you can collaborate with
 - ◆ Build a cohort that you feel comfortable asking advice of and brainstorming with
 - ◆ Receive from and give referrals to people you trust
- An Instagram and Facebook page that promotes individual and collective pursuits made by members of The Collective
- Ad campaigns via Facebook, Instagram, print, and other mediums The Collective may decide upon

Membership in The Asheville Wedding Collective lasts for 12 months which begins on the date this contract is signed. As a member of the Collective you agree to the following during the 12 months for which you are a member:

1. Attend and participate in at least 2 of the bi-monthly Collective meetings per year
2. Strive to sell at least 2 tickets to The Rehearsal
3. Post that you are a member of The Collective on your website, Facebook page, and all other social media accounts
 - a. Connect with all other members of The Collective on both Facebook and Instagram
 - b. Make at least one social media posting per month and tag The Collective in the post by officially tagging them or by putting #ashevilleweddingcollective in the text of the post or in the comment section
 - c. If you do not renew your contract, you agree to remove any wording on your website and social media bio(s) that indicates current membership)
4. Maintain at least a 4 star rating on Google Business
 - a. If you receive a bad rating, please reach out to the person who left the review to ask for feedback within 5 days of the review and work to resolve their concerns.
 - b. If the person is not able or willing to update the review after you have attempted to discuss it with them, you will alert The Collective within 2 weeks of the review.

5. Be courteous and kind to other members of The Collective. If you disagree with a member, please work to handle the disagreement amiably. If you are unable to do so, you may be asked to leave The Collective.
 - a. You understand that The Collective does not bear responsibility for the actions or conduct of any individual member
 - b. The Collective will not arbitrate disputes among its members
6. You will not make a similar “collective” or local registry in the Western North Carolina/Asheville region. However, you are free to join other groups of vendors or create your own group, so long as it is not a “collective” nor has a registry component.
7. Vendor dues are non-refundable.

By submitting your vendor application and checking the Terms of Agreement box, you are agreeing to this document therefore stating, I agree that I have received, read, and understand my rights regarding this contract in its entirety. I agree to the payment and terms of this contract.
